Scenic Rivers Land Trust is celebrating 30 years of protecting land and water in Anne Arundel County with a “Conservation Celebration!” fundraising gala to be held on Thursday, October 10, 2019 at The Bistro at South River in Edgewater, Maryland.

A nonprofit dedicated to protecting forests, wetlands, farmlands and other open spaces in Anne Arundel County, Scenic Rivers uses land conservation easements to protect special places from development and provide financial incentives to property owners. To date, Scenic Rivers holds 68 conservation easements across the county, totaling 3,000 acres—or about one percent of county land.

Once conservation agreements are in place, we assist landowners in the ongoing stewardship of their land. Our efforts are unique because they provide protection for both large and small parcels, safeguarding critical wildlife habitat in the woodlands and protecting the water quality of nearby streams and rivers.

This event will bring together **over 100** county leaders, heads of partner environmental organizations, dedicated land conservation supporters and friends to celebrate the value of land protection, honor the work that has been done so far, and gear up for the years of work that lie ahead.

Your sponsorship of Scenic Rivers’ first-ever fundraising gala will ensure that we can continue preserving and protecting the open lands that make Anne Arundel County a vibrant and healthy home for us all.
